MMMM..... What can I make from this piece of plywood or 2x4?

Turners, here is the challenge. Take a piece of plywood, or a length of 2x4 and create a turning. Could be anything from a bowl, a platter, square plate, vase, pen, peppermill, ornament, Tim Heil rolling pin, spoons, baseball bat, anything... Get creative. You can add some accent wood, or carvings, or paint but the bulk of the project is either plywood or 2x4 or even both.

Most of us have some plywood or 2x4 laying around, so don't go nuts and buy a big sheet of plywood. The idea here is to creatively think maybe about layout, grain orientation, form, etc..

Maybe you have wanted to try some stave or stacked ring construction. Maybe you have not resawn a board. This is a way to give it a try before you put that 4 inch wide, 2 inch thick 16 inch long piece of prized figured walnut on the table saw. Test out a plan first.
